

## Dual Credit Course Pathway

This chart serves as a guide only. For transfer credit information, please refer to our website.

- You must apply to your course professor for transfer credits within the first 10 school days of the academic semester
- You will need to provide all supporting documents to your professor, including official transcripts and course descriptions
- Courses that are approved for transfer credit are listed on your academic transcripts, but not calculated in your program weighted average

Normally, transfer credits are only granted for credits obtained within seven years of the request
